Twelve low-cost computer systems were installed in the Philippines and Tanzania, reaching **11,710** students

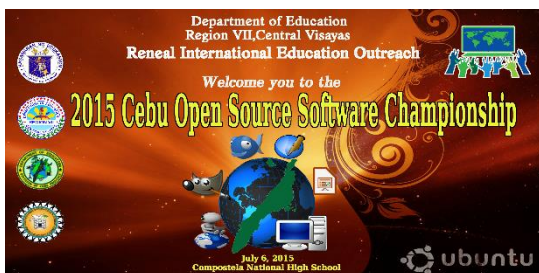
Almost **140 used computers** received new life in schools

40 students and **22 coaches** participated in the COSSC

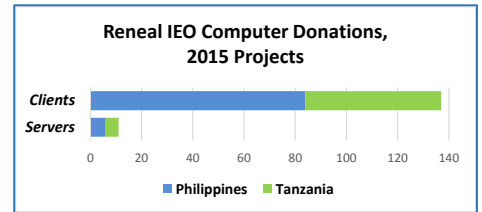
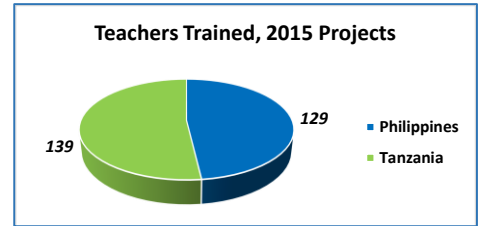
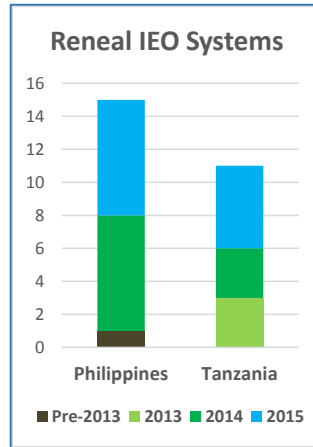
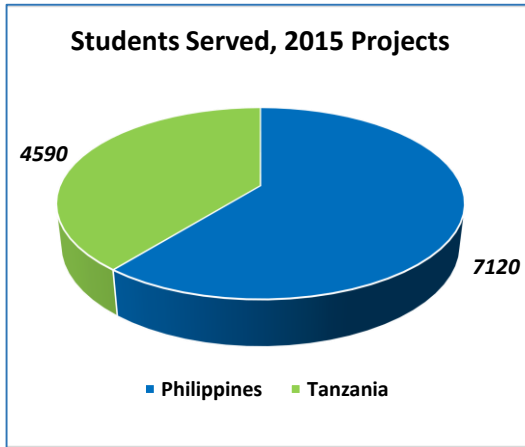
Scholarships were provided for **10** high school students

Summary of 2015 Computer Lab Installations



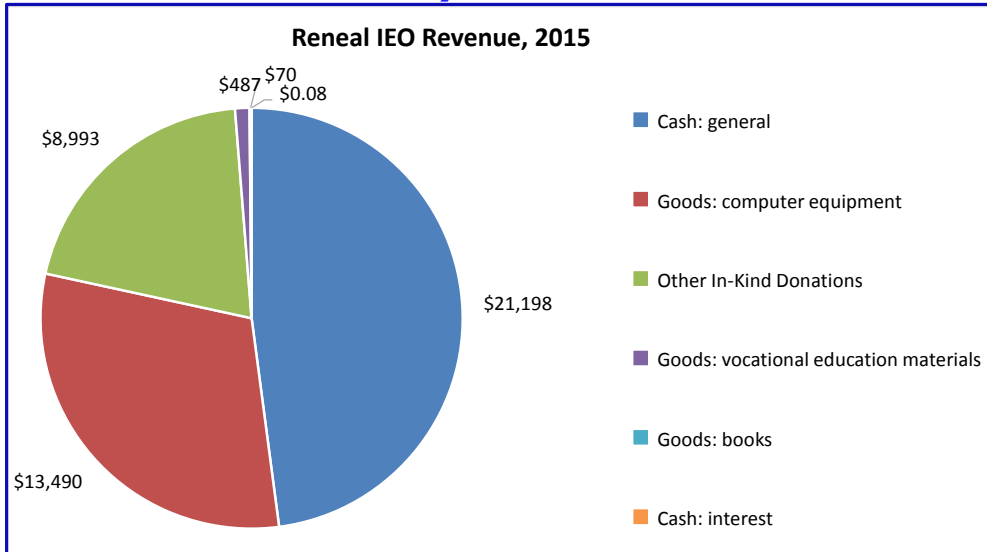

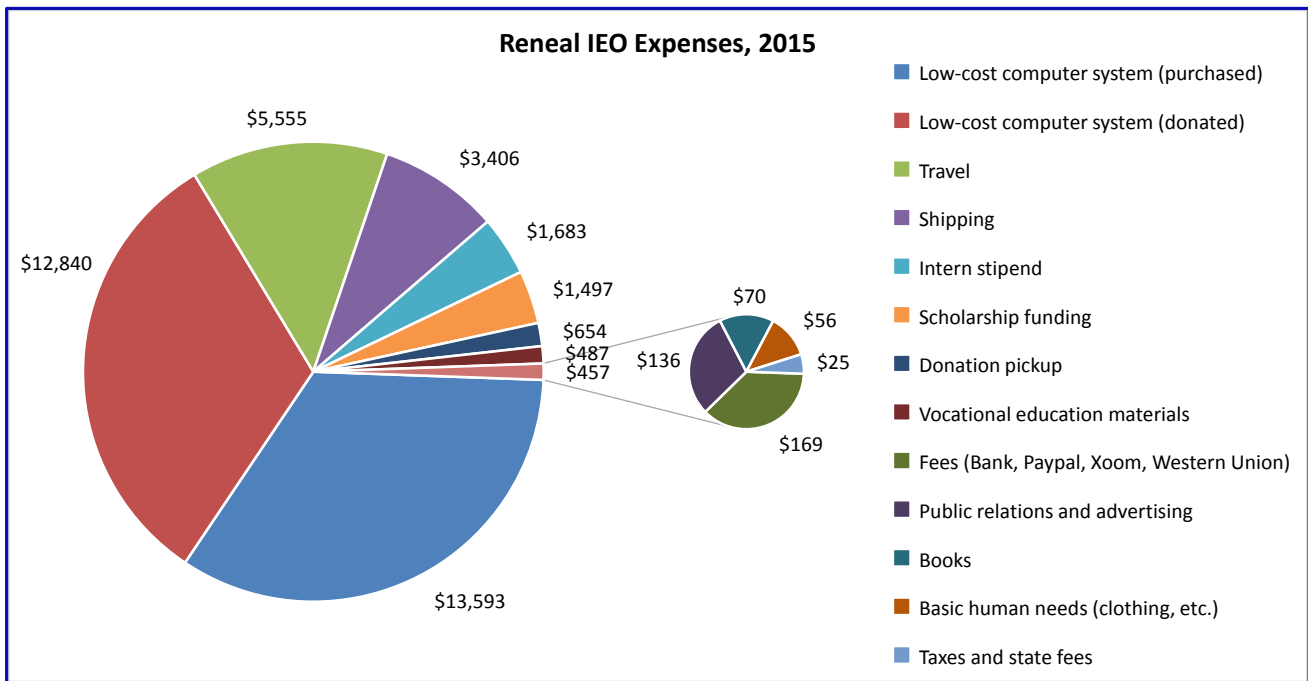
