In 2018 Renéal achieved a milestone of 50 computer lab installations since its inception. Along with expansion, our team made major upgrades to existing computer labs in both Tanzania and the Philippines. We also celebrated our 10<sup>th</sup> year of providing scholarships to deserving public high school students, with significant growth in the program in the Philippines and the first-ever scholarships in Tanzania in 2018.

## ***2018 Accomplishments***

Renéal installed **ten new computer labs** in schools in the Philippines and Tanzania, including our first university

Renéal awarded high school **scholarships** to **20 Philippines day students** and **6 Tanzania boarding students**

**133 teachers** received ICT training

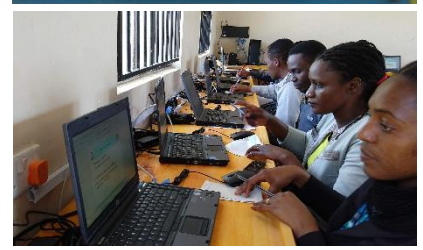
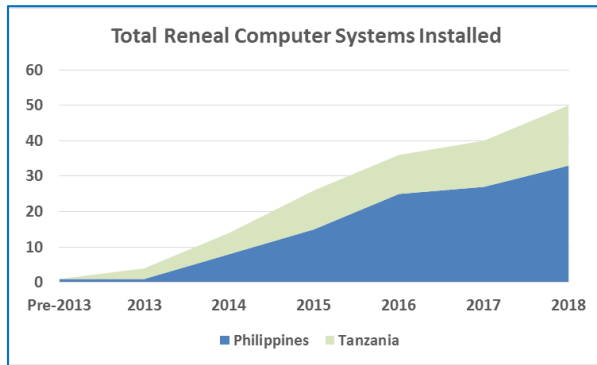
**Over 200 used computers** began new lives in 2018 serving students

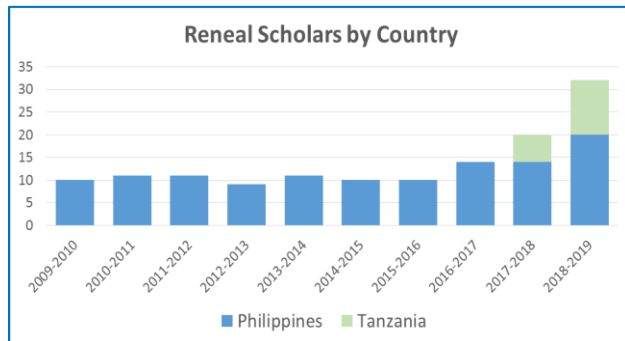

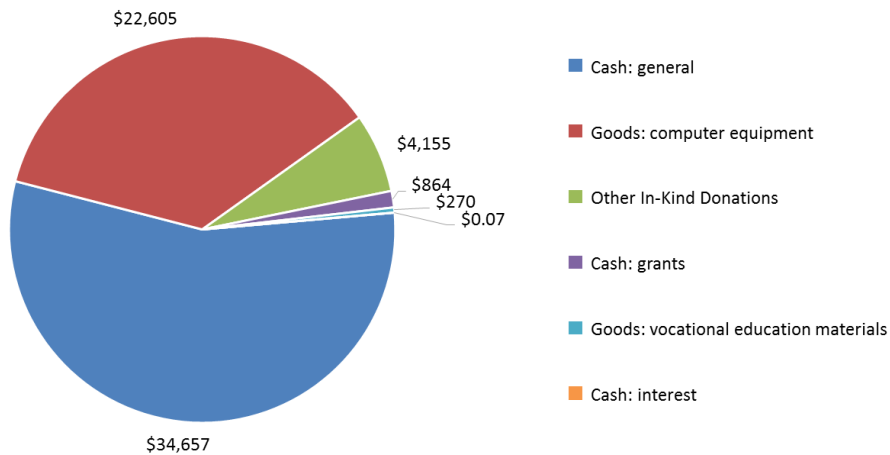

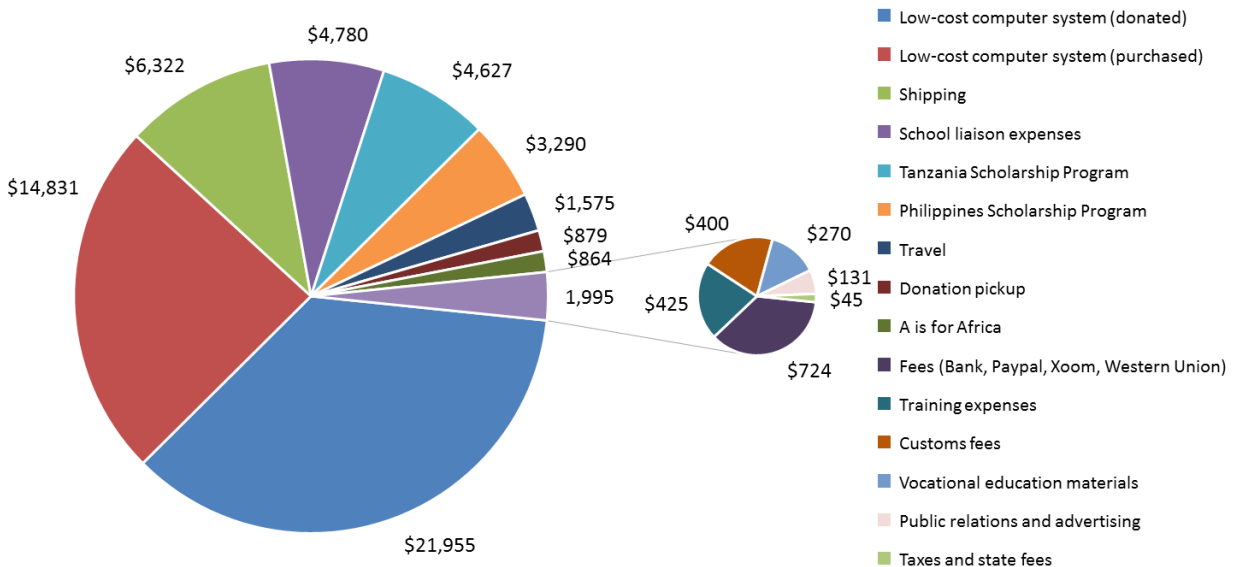
