A message from the Board...

In 2019 Reneal had its biggest year ever in Tanzania, extending Reneal computer labs to 20 high schools in Arusha District plus deploying two computer labs solely for the use of advanced level students. Reneal continued to make major upgrades to existing computer labs in both Tanzania and the Philippines. This year also brought a doubling in the size of the scholarship program in Tanzania, which is now supporting twelve boarding scholars.

2019 Accomplishments

Reneal installed **nine new computer labs** in schools in Tanzania and the Philippines

Reneal awarded high school **scholarships** to **20 Philippines day students** and **12 Tanzania boarding students**

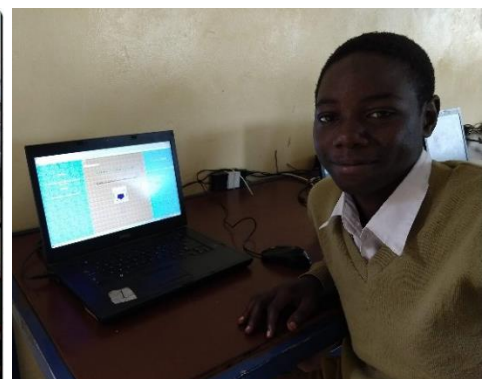
124 teachers received ICT training

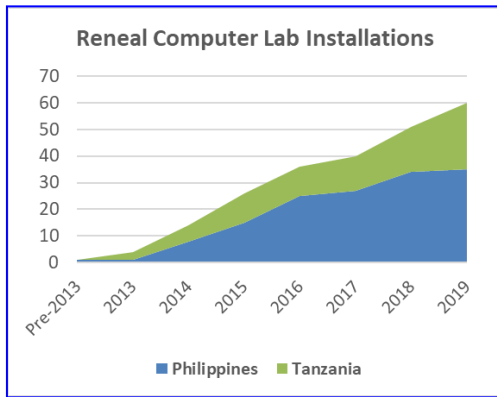

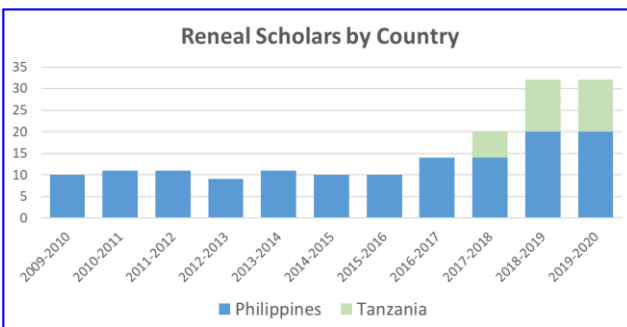
Students at Mlangarini Secondary School in Arusha are learning about webpage design. Reneal computers give them hands-on experience to put into practice the concepts they are studying.

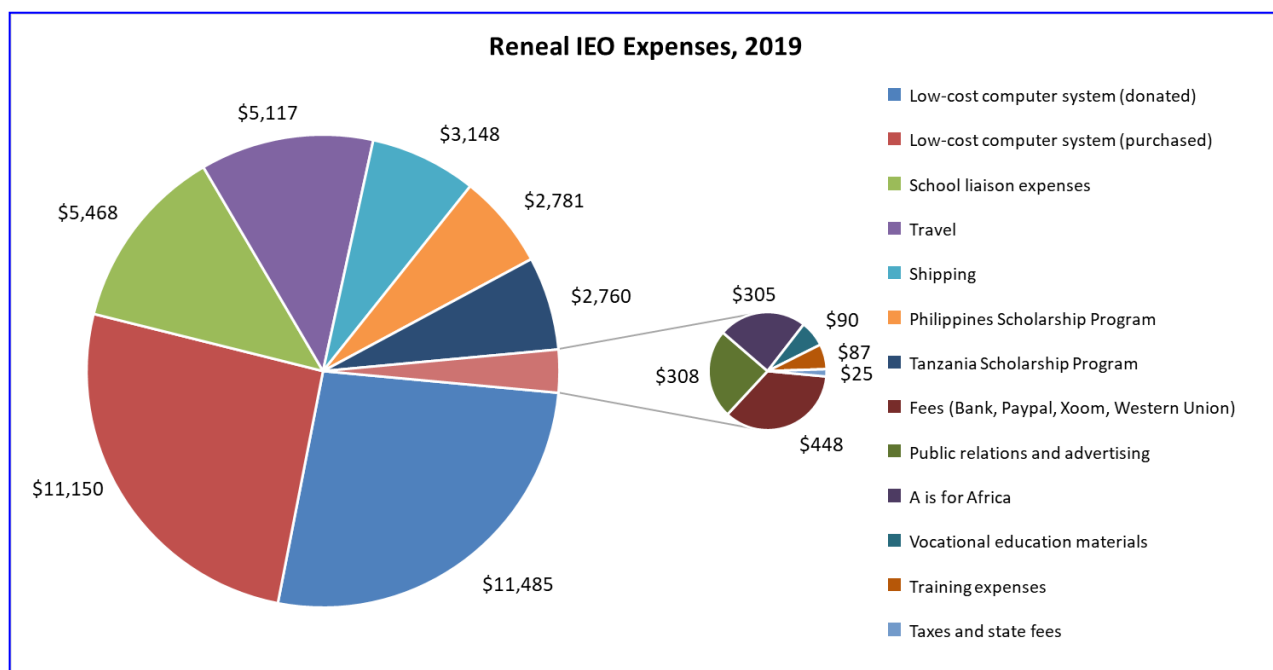
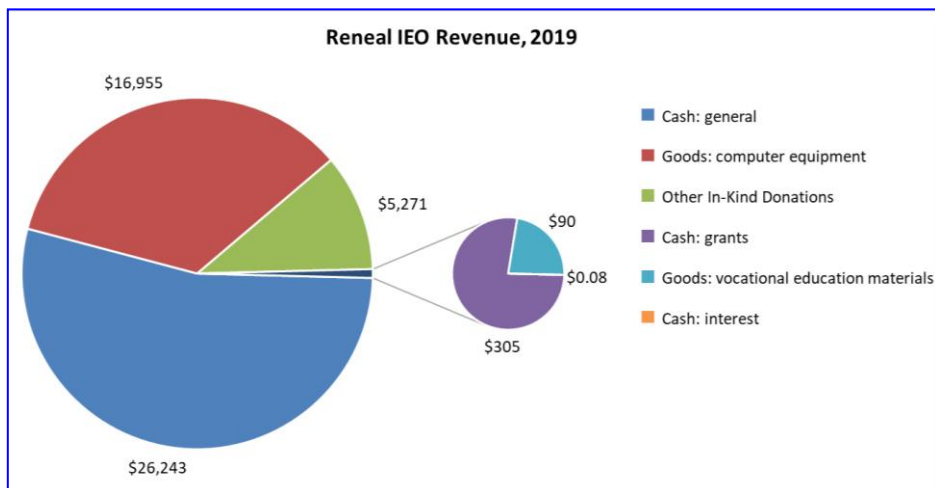
Renear Scholarships
