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The Challenge to Schools

The task is difficult ...

- Many different types of information to manage
- Historical information, not just current status
- Need to consolidate at the school, Division, Regional, National levels
- The resources are small ...
 - Teachers' time is limited and School Administrators have many priorities
 - Resources for computer infrastructure are limited

Scope of the Project

Student Data:

- Personal information
- School history
- Enrollment information (present and past)
- Special events and activities
- Grades
- Attendance

Scope of the Project

- Institutional Data:
 - Classes
 - School information
 - Municipality/barangay information
 - Information about teachers/administrators

Scope of the Project

 Focused on high schools, but the same approach could be extended to elementary schools

Design Specifics

- Uses Open Source software
 - Can be changed as policies evolve
 - Free and legal
- Internet based (Google Apps database)
- Flexible design allows for future enhancements

Features and Benefits

- No centralized infrastructure needed for data
 - No servers or server maintenance required
 - Scales almost indefinately
- Software is managed centrally for ease of upgrade and maintenance
- School needs internet but no other expensive software or servers
- Google offers some free disk storage space with a fee for additional space (P 7 / month for 20,000 students)

Features and Benefits

Data safety

 At least three copies automatically saved, in at least two different geographic locations

Data security

- Multiple classes of users, with control of permitted actions and permitted data for each
- Access permissions defined by school head or their delegate
- Password protected with automatic log-out after period of inactivity

Features and Benefits

- Information consolidation
 - Data immediately available as it is entered
 - Unified database structure makes data consolidation very easy
 - Summaries can be easily generated at school, Division, Regional, National level
- Flexibility
 - Data can be imported from and exported to spreadsheets
 - Reports can be created in printer ready PDF format

Status of the Project

- Development still underway
- Basic data structures in place
- Initial web site with functional interface active
- Sample data loaded from current CNHS database and national municipality and barangay list
